No additional eBooks are required to be purchased for iPad users in 3rd Year.

However, please refer to the 3rd Year Booklist when it becomes available on the school website for non-eBook items required in 3rd Year such as Past Exam Papers.

Although no new textbooks or eBooks are required in 3rd Year, we are very pleased to inform you that Wriggle have now partnered with The Book Haven for physical textbook purchases.

Going forward, students will receive the physical textbook and a free eBook for all orders purchased on the Wriggle online store. These orders will be processed and individually packaged and boxed for each student by the Book Haven for no additional charge and delivered to the school at the beginning of the academic year. The introduction this year of the physical textbook and free eBook bundle has proven to be very successful and welcomed by all. This also allows us to develop and focus our use of iPad in the classroom on the enhancement of teaching and learning using digital active learning methodologies to support student learning.
