



Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

The following information provides details for the purchase of iPad and textbooks with free eBooks for those who have decided they would like their daughter to opt-in to the 1:1 iPad Programme.

Step 1 - Purchase from the Wriggle Online Store

If you would like your daughter to opt-in to the 1:1 iPad programme, this would entail purchasing an iPad and textbooks with free eBooks from the Wriggle Online for 2nd Year.

To access the 2nd Year online store please visit www.wriggle.ie.

Click 'Order Online' and input the following code: **56147170**

- Please purchase from the normal 2nd Year Online Store. The 'new' 2nd Year Online Store is only intended for use by students who are new to the school and require all 1st and 2nd Year purchases.
- You will not be able to purchase an iPad from the 2nd Year Online Store. The purchase of an iPad for 2nd Year, if required, will be made when you contact Wriggle by phone (see below for more details).

Wriggle have now partnered with The Book Haven for physical textbook purchases. Students will receive the physical textbook and a free eBook for all orders purchased on the Wriggle online store. These orders will be processed and individually packaged and boxed for each student for no additional charge by the Book Haven and delivered to the school at the beginning of the 2017-2018 academic year during the first week of school.

Please find attached the eBooklist for 2nd Year.

Items listed in red will be purchased from the Wriggle Online Store.

Other items listed in black, including some additional textbooks/activity books/workbooks, stationary, hardbacks and copies, art supplies, etc., should be purchased separately from a retail store (i.e. a bookshop or stationary supplies shop).

The booklist also details which of the textbooks purchased in 1st Year should be retained in 2nd and 3rd Year.

NOTE:

Maths - Active Maths 2 should only be selected by those who are studying Higher Level Maths. If you are unsure of your daughter's subject level for 2nd year, please contact the school and/or her Maths Teacher for advice on this. The online store will be reopened in late-September to allow for the purchase of the Higher Level Maths textbook, if required.

Irish - You will select 'Irish textbook' when purchasing on the online store. However, Higher and Ordinary Level Irish students will have two different textbooks; Aois Na Gloire 2 for Ordinary Level and Aois Na Gloire 3 for Higher Level. Class groups and subject levels for Irish (i.e. Higher and Ordinary Level) will not be finalised by the Irish Department until September. Once this has been completed, each student's subject level will be forwarded to Wriggle and the correct numbers of each textbook will then be delivered to the school and the correct Irish eBook will be made available on student iPads.

Please ensure that purchases are made before the closing date on 21st July. An increased charge will be applied to all late orders and may result in your daughter's textbooks and eBooks not being available in time for the new school year.

Note about 1st Year Textbooks (and eBooks)

We would advise continuing to use the textbooks already purchased in 1st Year.

In most cases, it would be possible to activate the free eBook license for 2016 textbook purchases if they were required.

However, this would not be possible for any textbook purchases made prior to the 2016-2017 academic year.

The textbooks may contain a sticker or note on the front or inside cover indicating that a free eBook can be downloaded (if the sticker or note is not present with the required information, this offer will not be granted by the publisher regardless of when the textbook was purchased).

Wriggle might be able to provide some assistance with this when you contact them, but may only be able to provide guidance of how to go about this as the original purchase was not made through them.

Bring Your Own Device Option (BYOD)

You can also choose the BYOD iPad option (Bring Your Own Device) for those who already own a suitable iPad (iPad Air 1 or later model). This device would be erased and reset and will be set-up and used exclusively for schoolwork.

Step 2 - Contact Wriggle by Phone

After purchasing from the 2nd Year Online Store, please contact Wriggle by phone: 01-5009060.

Please indicate with them that your daughter is opting in to the 1:1 Programme in 2nd Year and that you have purchased textbooks with free eBooks from the 2nd Year Online Store.

At this stage you will be able to purchase an iPad and protective case (or select the BYOD iPad option - see above), purchase the required Wriggle Support and Services and provide details for the creation of user accounts i.e. Apple ID and Publisher eBook accounts. Please have a record of your daughter's school email address and password to provide to Wriggle for this purpose.

Step 3 - iPad Deployment: Monday 28th August

Your daughter will then be required to attend iPad deployment with Wriggle in school on Monday 28th August.

Further details on this will be forwarded later in the summer.

I have also attached the iPad Deployment Information Leaflet for 2017. This information is intended primarily for the Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of Incoming 1st Year students 2017-2018, but has important information relevant to all students new to the 1:1 iPad Programme.

If you do not wish for your daughter to opt-in to the 1:1 iPad Programme, no response or action is required.

The 2nd Year Booklist has been made available to all Parents/Guardians by email and will soon also be available on the school website to make traditional textbook purchases.
